- 1) In WILD, we don't believe that there are 'born leaders.' Anyone can learn to be a good leader. But they have to want to learn.

Please tell us why you want to learn to be a leader. Where are you going to use the skills you've learned?

- 2) Think for a moment about something that you've done in your life so far that was really a challenge. It should be something you feel proud about. What was it? How did you do it? What was the secret to your success? Did you ever feel like quitting? What did you learn from this experience?

- 3) WILD is not like regular camp. You will have much more responsibility. WILD campers work with other people almost all the time in this program. We're a team, and that means being responsible and respectful.

What have you done in your life or are doing now that you believe shows you are a responsible person?

- 4) Sometimes people are not respectful. Please give us some examples of disrespectful behavior that you have seen by people your own age. Share some respectful behavior as well. What have you done, or could you do when you witness disrespectful behavior?

- 5) Have you ever seen a really great magic trick and wondered how it was done? We do the same sort of thing in our program. We look at people who are good leaders and ask, 'How do they do that?' We try to figure out why they are so good, because then that helps us figure out how to be good leaders ourselves.

Please take a moment to think of the best youth leader that you've ever met. This could be a camp counselor, a community or religious leader, or a teacher. What does this person say or do that makes you think that they are a good leader?

- 6) WILD participants are often in different places along their spiritual journey. In the WILD program we accept each person where they are and provide the opportunity to explore and strengthen their faith at their own pace.
